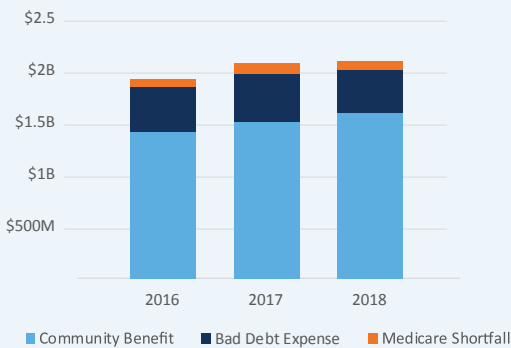
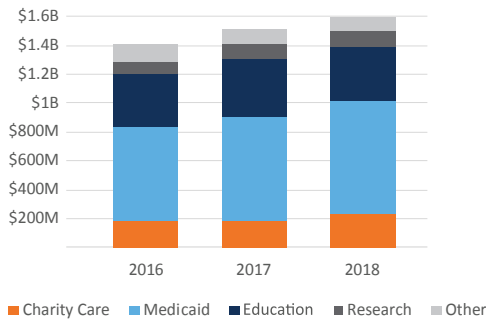
Programs and activities that provide treatment or promote health and healing as a response to community needs.

2018 Northeast Ohio Hospital Community Benefit: **\$1.598 billion**



2018 Community Benefit + Medicare Shortfall + Bad Debt = **\$2.098 billion**

Medicare shortfall and bad debt are additional ways hospitals contribute to their communities through subsidization of care.

TOTAL UNCOMPENSATED CARE

2018 Charity Care + Bad Debt = **\$642.3 million**

All reported cost data is net of any offsetting revenues.
